




Organization – Board of Officers



Officers Roles & Responsibilities









Chapter Chairperson/Chief Executive Officer:

- Preside over all chapter meetings.
- Perform all duties usually pertaining to a chief executive officer and chairman of the board for the chapter.
- In the absence of the chapter's secretary at any chapter meeting, designate another chapter officer to perform the secretary's duties.
- Review and approve the minutes of each chapter meeting and special activity.
- **Regional Vice Chairs operate as the CEO for their** respective regions. (AFDW/DE/MD/Tidewater VA/WV)
 - Master of ceremony at luncheons in their region.
 - Manage SF, veterans, and members in the region MD excludes Andrews).
 - Respond to members, SF units and other organizations on behalf of the chapter.
 - Coordinate activities for their region.
- Chief Financial Officer/Treasurer
 - Deposit, maintain and report on chapter finances/501, C (19).
 - Report on chapter finances at each chapter meeting.
 - Register attendees at chapter luncheons.
 - Award checks for SF Booster Club/SF Key Spouse clubs.

- Provide membership status at chapter meetings


• Vice Chair, Public Information (VCPI)
